# Youth Family Unification Program Voucher?

With a Youth Family Unification Program (FUP-Y) voucher, you will pay around 30% of your adjusted monthly income to rent and the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Cruz will cover the remaining rent. The voucher lasts for at least three years, with the opportunity to extend it for an additional two years.

You've got a team to help! You'll have access to people who can help you find, move into, and stay housed while you work on goals that matter to you for at least 36 months.



### → Support Applying for the Voucher

There's some paperwork to fill out for the voucher. We can help you manage all of those documents and turn them into the Housing Authority.

#### **→** Locating Housing

Locating housing can be tricky! We can help you find housing, talk to landloards, and apply for housing.

#### → Move-In Support

Once you've found housing, we've got to make it your space. We can help you move your things, buy furniture, and feel at home in your new space. Plus money to support with your security deposit!


#### + Reaching Your Goals


We know you've got goals! We are here to help in anyway we can to help you reach them whether you want to go to college, reconnect with loved ones, or get connected to a doctor.

# Who can use a Youth Family Unification Program Voucher?






Are you experiencing homelessness or worried about how you will maintain your housing?
